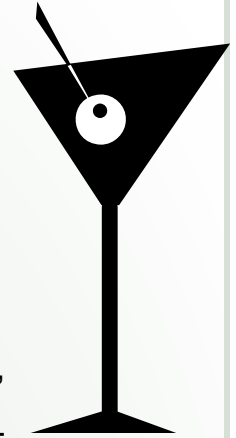
According to Federal Government figures, by 2012 Australia can expect an annual influx of 10.4 million tourists, who will collectively generate nearly \$35 billion in earnings.
